About the Presenter:

Lori Rugle, Ph.D. is the Director of Problem Gambling Services with the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services for the State of Connecticut. Her career has included the treatment of problem gamblers and their families in a range of clinical settings including both public and private inpatient, residential and outpatient programs. Her work in the public sector included many years as Director of the Gambling Treatment Program at the Cleveland Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center and Deputy Director of their Veterans Addiction Recovery Center. She also developed privately funded inpatient and outpatient treatment programs and has provided consultation for state funded problem gambling programs throughout the US, for the military in Germany and the Government of Singapore. Dr. Rugle has been involved in a variety of research projects including studies of treatment outcome, attention deficits among pathological gamblers, neuroimaging and pharmacotherapy with problem gamblers, coping skills among homeless problem gamblers and PTSD among pathological gamblers.

Description:

An overview of the research on substance use and mental health disorders that commonly co-occur with problem gambling will be reviewed. Participants will have the opportunity to develop and practice specific assessment and treatment approaches for working with problem gambling in clients with multiple diagnoses.

Objectives:

- Participants will be able to identify substance use and mental health disorders that are commonly co-occurring with problem gambling
- Participants will be able to identify assessment techniques to assist in both identifying problem gambling in other substance use and mental health disorders and to identify co-occurring disorders among problem gambling clients
- Participants will be able to identify and utilize treatment strategies to develop integrated treatment approaches for individuals with problem gambling and other substance use or mental health disorders.
